

INTERNAL RULES FOR FISHING IN THE ALTO CHIESE YEAR 2026

ARTICLE 1 - IDENTIFICATION OF FISHING AREAS

SPECIAL ZONES

NK0 - ONLY FLY FISHING AND SPINNING.

The NO-KILL0 (Rio Lora) flows alongside the Storo cross-country field, starting at the confluence with the Chiese River and ending at the exit of the Foglio fish farm, where signs marking the start and end points will be placed. See Art. 6.

NK1 - ONLY FLY FISHING.

NO-KILL 1 is located in the municipalities of Borgo Chiese and Storo, on the Chiese River. It begins at the Cà Rossa bridge and ends at the ford that crosses the Chiese River leading to the quarry. This zone will be marked with special signs indicating its beginning and end. See Art. 6.

NK2 - ONLY FLY FISHING.

NO-KILL2 is located in the municipality of Pieve di Bono-Prezzo, situated in Chiese, starting upstream from the north bridge of the Cimego basin, up to the end of the municipal road "Via al Ben". This zone will be marked with special signs indicating its beginning and end. See Art. 6.

NK3 - ONLY FLY FISHING AND SPINNING.

The NO-KILL 3 zone is located on the Chiese River, starting from the Dastion bridge and ending at Vermongoi. This zone will be marked with special signs indicating its beginning and end. See Art. 6.

NK4 - ONLY FLY FISHING AND SPINNING.

The NO-KILL 4 zone is located on the Chiese River downstream from the Bissina basin, starting from the Ortigheta bridge and extending to the waterfall upstream from Piana di Nudole. This zone will be marked with special signs indicating its beginning and end. See Art. 6.

NK5 - ONLY FLY FISHING AND SPINNING.

The NO-KILL 5 is located on the Chiese River in Val di Fumo, starting in Serra, where there is a clearly visible sign, and extending 2 km upstream. This zone will be marked with special signs indicating its beginning and end. See Art. 6.

RF - ONLY FLY FISHING AND SPINNING.

The FORMIGHER RESERVE is located between the Armanini and Foglio fish farms, on the right bank of the Chiese River, upstream from the Tedeschi bridge. This zone will be marked with special signs indicating its beginning and end. See Art. 6.

- 1- The Chiese River from Lake Idro to the Tedeschi Bridge. See Art. 4.
- 2- The Chiese River from the Tedeschi Bridge to the confluence with Lake Chiese (Barambana). See Art. 4.

- 8- Chiese River upstream of the Boazzo reservoir to the start of NO-KILL 4 and from the end of NO-KILL 4 to 40 m from the foot of the Bissina reservoir. See Art.4
- 9- Chiese River Val di Fumo upstream of the Bissina reservoir to the start of NO-KILL 5 and from the end of NO-KILL 5 to the sources, including tributaries. See Art. 4

- 1- Annual catches are set at 150 pieces per member.
- 2- In all waters under licence of the Associazione Pescatori Alto Chiese A.S.D., the following may be caught daily: 5 Salmonids, e.g. 2 Trout plus 3 Arctic Char, or 4 Trout plus 1 Marble Trout, remembering to respect the prohibited periods and zones.

ARTICLE 4 – PROCEDURES AND PROHIBITIONS

- 1- Fishers must comply with provincial law on fishing P.L. No. 60 of 12/12/78 and the fishing regulation of the president of the provincial council No.21-34/leg. of 30 December 2020. Furthermore, fishers must adopt correct conduct during fishing activities with regard to the fish, the environment, other fishers and rangers.
- 2- Fishing is prohibited in lakes if more than 50% of the surface is covered by ice.
- 3- To fish in restricted access NO-KILL 0/1/2/3/4/5 areas, Formigher Reserve, Chiese River fishing area no. 9, Val di Fumo, guests and members must book in advance on the Hooking app or by calling Helga on +39 348 8449115. In addition, members must cancel by crossing out the squares for catches on the day they go fishing in one of these areas and must practise catch-and-release fishing throughout the day.
- 4- MEMBERS, IN ADDITION TO BEING REQUIRED TO BOOK IN ADVANCE TO FISH IN FISHING AREA NO. 9, MAY ONLY MAKE A MAXIMUM OF 8 OUTINGS PER YEAR. THEY MAY, HOWEVER, BOOK IN ADVANCE TO FLY FISHING OR SPINNING ONLY IN NO KILL MODE, AS PER ARTICLE NO. 6.
- 5- **Fishing is closed every TUESDAY and FRIDAY**, with the exception of public holidays.
- 6- **On normal Tuesdays and Fridays (workdays)** in the River Chiese MEMBERS and GUESTS must reserve their fishing trip via the App or through Helga and must do NO-KILL Fly Fishing or Spin Fishing only, as per the rules of Art. 6.
- 7- Before starting to fish, member fishers must fill out the membership card and guests must fill out the day permit.
- 8- Fishing is not permitted after catching and keeping the fifth salmonid, not even to try out equipment, bait or other items.
- 9- It is prohibited to accumulate catches with those made by other fishers.
- 10- During fishing, members must carry their valid fishing licence and paper or online membership card. Guests must carry a paper or online daily permit for the relevant fishing area. They must also carry identification showing their current place of residence. Members' or guests' documents must be shown upon request by the authorities responsible for surveillance.
- 11- In relation to others already on site, fishers must keep at a distance so as not to hinder peaceful fishing.
- 12- At the end of each day of fishing, members are required to report their total daily and weekly catches. At the end of the season, they are required to summarise their total catches in the appropriate tables.

- 13- THOSE WHO FISH WITH A DAILY GUEST PERMIT ARE REQUIRED TO RELEASE ALL THEIR CATCH. THEY ARE ONLY PERMITTED TO FISH WITH FLY OR SPINNING RODS AS PER ARTICLE 6, EXCEPT IN READY-TO-FISH AREAS AND ALPINE LAKES, WHERE FISHING IS PERMITTED AS DESCRIBED IN ARTICLE 7. THE GUEST PERMIT MUST BE COMPLETED CORRECTLY IN ALL FIELDS AND SIGNED BY THE FISHERMAN TO INDICATE THAT HE HAS READ AND ACCEPTS THE REGULATIONS, PRIVACY POLICY, ETC. ANYONE WHO TAKES FISH FROM READY-TO-FISH AREAS AT THE END OF THE DAY MUST RETURN IT TO ONE OF THE LOCAL SALES POINTS.
- 14- NIGHT FISHING IS ALWAYS PROHIBITED IN ALL WATERS OF THE UPPER CHIESE, EXCEPT FOR CERTAIN NIGHTS FOR FISHING AT LAKE CAMPO, WHICH WILL BE COMMUNICATED BY NOTICE POSTED ON THE NOTICE BOARDS BETWEEN 1 JULY AND 31 OCTOBER, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 11 OF THE PROVINCIAL FISHING REGULATIONS, ONLY FOR THE CATCH OF THE BOTTATRICE.
- 15- IN ALL FLOWING WATERS, IT IS PERMITTED TO:
 - a. the use of only one rod with one hook.
 - b. or two artificial flies;
 - c. or one artificial fly with a maximum of one treble hook or one single hook;
 - d. **ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.**

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1- In designated waters, fishing zones 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, NK0, 13, 14, and 16, fishing in the water is permitted from the opening of the season, while in all other zones, fishing from dry land is mandatory until 30 April. Crossing the water is permitted only when not fishing.
- 2- The use of landing nets is permitted in all waters, but only to remove fish that have already been hooked from the water.
- 3- The use of star light-type signal lights is prohibited.
- 4- Fishing with carnivorous fly larvae and scazzone is prohibited.
- 5- **PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF SILICONE BAIT IN ALL WATERS EXCEPT FOR FISHING IN READY-TO-FISH AREAS N°10 16 17 19 26 27 34 35 36 37 38 39 40 AND LAKES N No. 42, 43, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49 AND 50.**
- 6- **Fishermen may not fish for more than one consecutive day in the same fishing area, see Art. 7.**
- 7- **Fishing with live fish is prohibited, and it is forbidden to bring live fish to the fishing site.**
- 8- **It is forbidden to stop or pass with any vehicle at the barrier at the quarry ford in the municipality of Borgo Chiese.**

ARTICLE 5 – REGULATIONS FOR TOURIST FISHING AREAS N°4

- 1- This area is located along the Chiese River in the municipality of Borgo Chiese and is marked with the number 4 on special signs placed along the river.
- 2- **SILICONE BAIT IS PROHIBITED.**
- 3- **Members** are permitted to use all fishing techniques authorised in these regulations for flowing waters. See Article 4.
- 4- **GUESTS** wishing to fish in this area must book via the Hooking app or by calling Helga on +39 348 8449115, as access is restricted for guests.
- 5- **FOR GUESTS ALSO:**
 - a. It is forbidden to keep catches. Every fish caught must be unhooked with the utmost care without ever being pulled out of the water and using the landing net, which is mandatory.
 - b. Spinning fishing is permitted, with artificial bait, spinners, spoons and minnows, **WITH 1 HOOK OR SINGLE HOOK** or Spinfly.
 - c. Fly fishing is permitted with a fly line, Valsesian, Tenkara, strike indicator (float), with dry fly, terrestrial, nymph or strimmer; all practised with a single bait and a maximum of 2 hooks.
 - d. **ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.**

ARTICLE 6 – REGULATIONS FOR NO-KILL ZONES AND RESERVE WITH LIMITED ACCESS

A. NO-KILL 1 e NO-KILL 2 (SOLO MOSCA)

- 1- To fish in the aforesaid zone MEMBERS and GUESTS must have a reservation made via the App or by phoning Helga at n° 348 8449115.
- 2- Access to this zone is only permitted with fishing equipment, landing net and accessories, no baskets or other containers for transporting fish caught in other zones are allowed.
- 3- **SILICONE BAIT IS PROHIBITED.**
- 4- It is prohibited to keep the caught fish. All caught fish must be unhooked with utmost care and must never be taken from the water; use of the landing net is mandatory.

- 5- Fly fishing only is permitted with mice tails, Valsesiana flies, Tenkara flies, strike indicators (floats), with dry flies, terrestrial flies, nymph flies or streamer flies, **all with a single fly and a maximum of 2 hooks.**
- 6- **Fishing may not begin before 7 AM** and must end one hour after sunset.
- 7- **ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.**
- 8- After fishing in the NO-KILL2 zone it is permitted to continue fishing in the River Chiese from the end of the NO-KILL2 zone down towards the Morandino basin, always using CATCH AND RELEASE and respecting the rules of NO-KILL2

B. NO-KILL 0, NO-KILL 3, NO-KILL 4, NO-KILL 5 e FORMIGHER RESERVE (FLY FISHING AND SPINNING)

- 1- To fish in the aforesaid zone MEMBERS and GUESTS must have a reservation made via the App or by calling Helga at n° 348 8449115
- 2- Access to this zone is only permitted with fishing equipment, landing net and accessories, no baskets or other containers for transporting fish caught in other zones are allowed.
- 3- **SILICONE BAIT IS PROHIBITED.**
- 4- **Fishing may not begin before 7 AM** and must end one hour after sunset.
- 5- Fly fishing only is permitted with mice tails, Valsesiana flies, Tenkara flies, strike indicators (floats), with dry flies, terrestrial flies, nymph flies or streamer flies, **all with a single fly and a maximum of 2 hooks.**
- 6- It is prohibited to keep the caught fish. All caught fish must be unhooked with utmost care and must never be taken from the water; use of the landing net is mandatory.
- 7- Spinning fishing is permitted, using artificial bait, spinners, spoons and minnows, **WITH 1 HOOK OR SINGLE HOOK** or Spinfly.
- 8- **ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.**
- 9- After fishing in the Formigher reserve, fishing with NO CATCH LIMIT is also permitted in the section of the Chiese river marked with the numbers 1 – 2 – 3 during the period from the first Sunday in February to 30 September and from 1 October to 31 October in POO. From 1 November to 31 December, fishing is only permitted in the Formigher Reserve.
- 10- After fishing in NO-KILL 3, it is permitted to fish with NO CATCH LIMIT also in the section of the Chiese river marked with the number 7 from the Morandino reservoir at the beginning of NO-KILL 3 and from the end of NO-KILL 3 to the Boazzo reservoir.
- 11- After fishing in NO-KILL 4, it is also permitted to fish with NO CATCH LIMIT in the section of the Chiese river marked with no. 8 from the Boazzo reservoir at the start of NO-KILL 4 and from the end of NO-KILL 4 to the Bissina reservoir.
- 12- After fishing in NO-KILL 5, it is also permitted to fish with NO CATCH in the section of the Chiese river marked with no. 9 from the Bissina reservoir to the start of NO-KILL 5 and from the end of NO-KILL 5 to the source.

ARTICLE 7 – REGULATIONS FOR READY FISHING, ALPINE LAKES, ROVERSELLA AND GREGGI

- 1- Ready-to-fish fishing is closed **every TUESDAY and FRIDAY**, with the exception of public holidays.
- 2- The fishing areas are named with the n° 10 16 17 19 26 27 34 35 36 37 38 39 40
- 3- **GUESTS MAY ONLY KEEP THEIR CATCH IN FISHING AREAS °10 16 17 19 26 27 34 35 36 37 38 39 40 42 43 45 46 47 48 49 50, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS REGULATION.**
- 4- **FISHERS MAY NOT FISH FOR MORE THAN ONE CONSECUTIVE DAY IN THE SAME READY-TO-FISH ZONE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ZONES: n°39 (MALGA BOAZZO BASIN), n°40 (MALGA BISSINA BASIN).**
- 5- **Fishing with worms (earthworms), honey worms, artificial bait or silicone bait is permitted.**
- 6- **FISHING ZONES n°34-35 36 e 37**
In the waters of Greggi, Roversella, the Cimego basin and Morandino:
 - a. Only one rod may be used with one hook
 - b. or with a fly rod or bait rod with a maximum of five hooks in total
 - c. or, for artificial bait only, one treble hook or single hook.
 - d. Fishing is permitted on the bridge leading to the Cimego reservoir power station, as provided for in Article
 - e. No. 16 of the provincial fishing law.
 - f. Anglers may not park their cars near the junction leading to
 - g. the central bridge of the reservoir or on the property of Hydro Dolomiti, where parking is prohibited.
 - h. It is strictly forbidden to cross the fences of the reservoirs to go fishing.
- 7- **ZONE 38 DAMPONE BASIN**
 - a. In the Dampone basin, fishing is permitted no further than the signs and buoys marking the photovoltaic panels.
 - b. In the waters of the Dampone basin, only one rod with one hook is permitted, with weights weighing no more than 8 grams in total
 - c. or with a fly rod or worm rod with a maximum of 5 hooks in total

- d. or, for artificial bait only, with a single hook or one treble hook.
 - e. It is strictly forbidden to go beyond the fences surrounding the basin and beyond the marker buoys. Violators will be punished with the immediate withdrawal of their membership or daily permit, in accordance with the penalty regulations.
- 8- **READY-TO-FISH ZONES No. 10, 16, 17, 19, 26, 27.**
- a. Only one rod may be used with one hook
 - b. or two artificial flies
 - c. or one artificial fly with a single treble hook or single hook
 - d. ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.
 - e. Anglers may not fish for more than one consecutive day in the same fishing area, with the exception of the Boazzo and Malga Bissina reservoirs.
- 9- **IN THE BOAZZO BASIN NO. 39 AND BISSINA BASIN NO. 40**
- a. The use of **two rods** is permitted, using:
 - b. only one hook per rod
 - c. only one treble hook per rod
 - d. or one artificial lure with a single treble hook or a single hook
 - e. The use of a fly or camoliera with a maximum of five hooks in total is permitted.
- 10- **IN THE ALPINE LAKES**
- Members and guests are permitted to use:
- a. 2 rods using only 1 hook per rod
 - b. Only 1 treble hook per rod
 - c. For artificial bait only, 1 treble hook or single hook.
 - d. The use of a fly or camouflage net with a maximum of 5 hooks in total.

ARTICLE 8 – REGULATIONS FOR LAKE AMPOLA AND COPIDELLO

LAKE AMPOLA AND COPIDELLO ARE CLOSED

ARTICLE 9 – FISHING REGULATIONS IN OCTOBER FROM 1 OCTOBER TO 31 OCTOBER IN ZONES NKO, PO0, PO1, PO2, PO3, PO4, RF, N°12

- 1- Members and guests wishing to fish in these areas must book via the Hooking app or by calling Helga on +39 348 8449115, as access is limited.
- 2- Fishing is permitted in October with the following restrictions and requirements:
- 3- Fly fishing with a rat tail, Valsesian, Tenkara, strike indicator (float), dry fly, terrestrial, nymph or strimmer is permitted, all practised with a single bait and a maximum of two hooks.
- 4- Spinning fishing is permitted, using artificial bait, spinners, spoons and minnows, **WITH 1 HOOK OR SINGLE HOOK** or Spinfly.
- 5- **ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.**
- 6- **SILICONE BAIT IS PROHIBITED.**
- 7- It is strictly forbidden to keep any fish caught, and they must be released without causing harm using the landing net, which is mandatory.
- 8- Prohibition on the use of silicone lures, rubber lures, dough baits and natural bait.
- 9- The use of a landing net is mandatory.
- 10- Fishing may not commence before 7 am and must cease one hour after sunset.

ARTICLE 10 – PENALTIES

- 1- In all cases of proven contravention, in addition to issuing a fine, the Association reserves the right to take legal action against the offender for compensation for damages resulting from the contravention itself.
- 2- For anything not mentioned in the above regulations, the provisions of the general internal regulations and provincial fishing regulations L.P. 12/12/78 No. 60 and fishing regulations of 30 December 2020 No. 21-34/LEG shall apply.
- 3- Any member who fishes in violation of these rules, even with a daily permit, will be declared an undesirable member and may have their membership card or daily permit revoked. Members whose membership card or daily permit is revoked are not entitled to any refund.
- 4- Anyone who fails to comply with a provision of these Regulations for the first time, applicable to all points and letters, whether a member or guest, will have their membership card or daily permit withdrawn for **30 (thirty) days of fishing**.
- 5- Any member or guest who, within a period of TWO YEARS, receives one (1) further penalty for any point or letter of the internal regulations will have their membership card or daily permit withdrawn for **60 (sixty) days of fishing**.
- 6- Members or guests who commit the same offence twice within a two-year period will have their membership card or daily permit withdrawn for **90 (ninety) days of fishing**.
- 7- A member or guest who incurs three penalties shall be considered an undesirable member or guest for a period to be determined by the current Board of Directors.
- 8- All penalties not completed in the same fishing year will be carried over to the following year of the membership card.
- 9- In the cases provided for in Art. 22 of Provincial Law No. 60/78 and subsequent amendments and additions, fish caught illegally will be confiscated and handed over to the concessionaire, and the membership card or daily fishing permit will be suspended in accordance with the procedures indicated under Penalties in these Regulations. If a member or guest fisherman is found to have committed an infringement and a report is filed, they must hand over their membership card or daily permit to the President.
- 10- PENALTY DAYS ARE TO BE COUNTED EXCLUDING TUESDAYS AND FRIDAYS THAT ARE NOT PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

- 1- It is strictly **FORBIDDEN TO LEAVE WASTE** of any kind in fishing areas, both on the shore and in the water.
- 2- All fishermen are requested to pay close attention to signs bearing the words **“POSSIBILITY OF SUDDEN FLOODING”**.
- 3- All anglers are requested to exercise extreme caution when using carbon rods or similar alloys near **POWER LINES** or during storms.
- 4- All fishermen are requested to immediately report any dangerous situations, **CASES OF POLLUTION OR ENVIRONMENTAL DAMAGE** that come to their attention to the supervisory authorities.
- 5- **PLEASE NOTE THAT – IN CASE OF EMERGENCY – THE SINGLE EMERGENCY NUMBER FOR THE ENTIRE TERRITORY IS 112.**
